that the toad was indeed royalty.



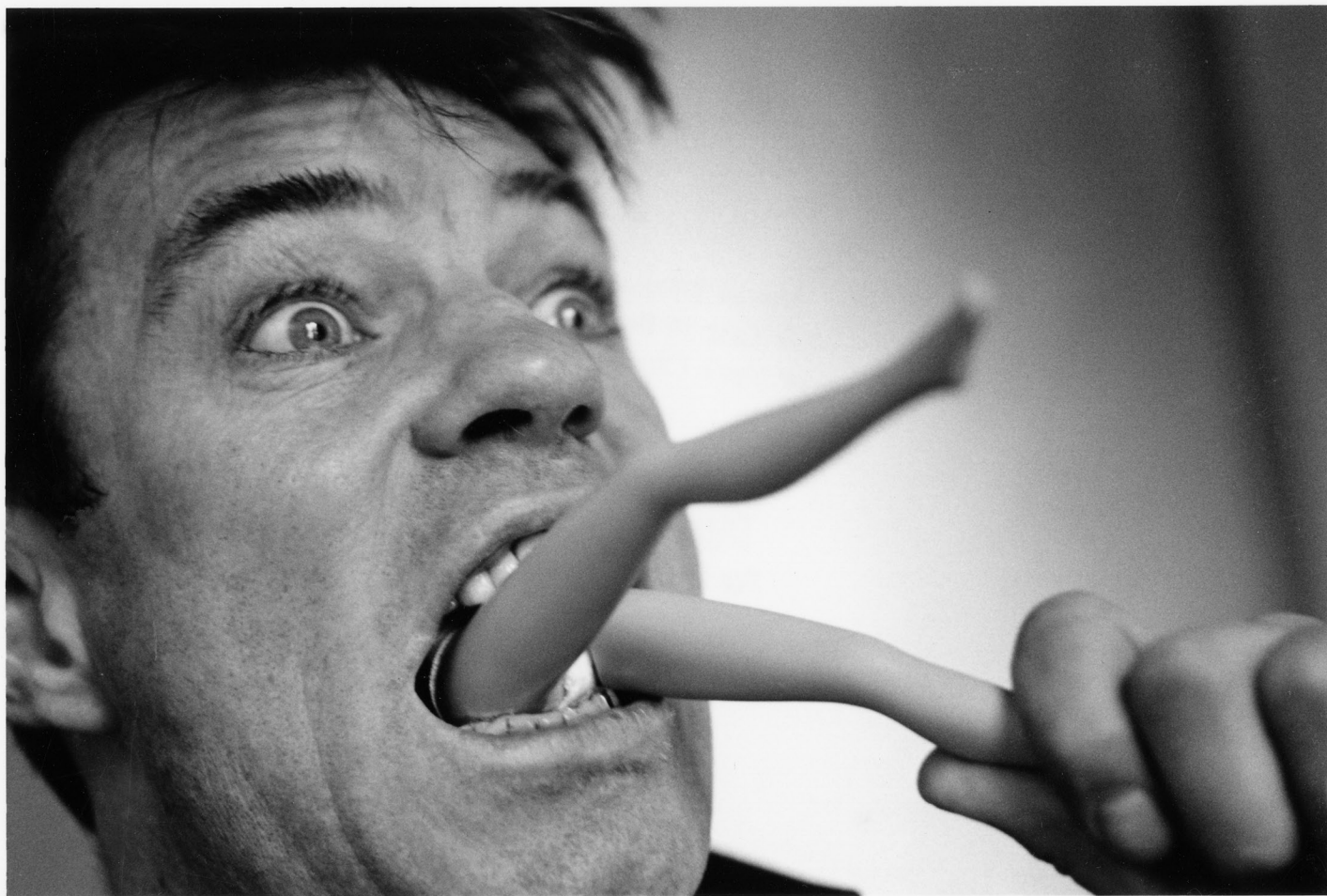
Unfortunately, he was Evil Arnold, the satanic prince


