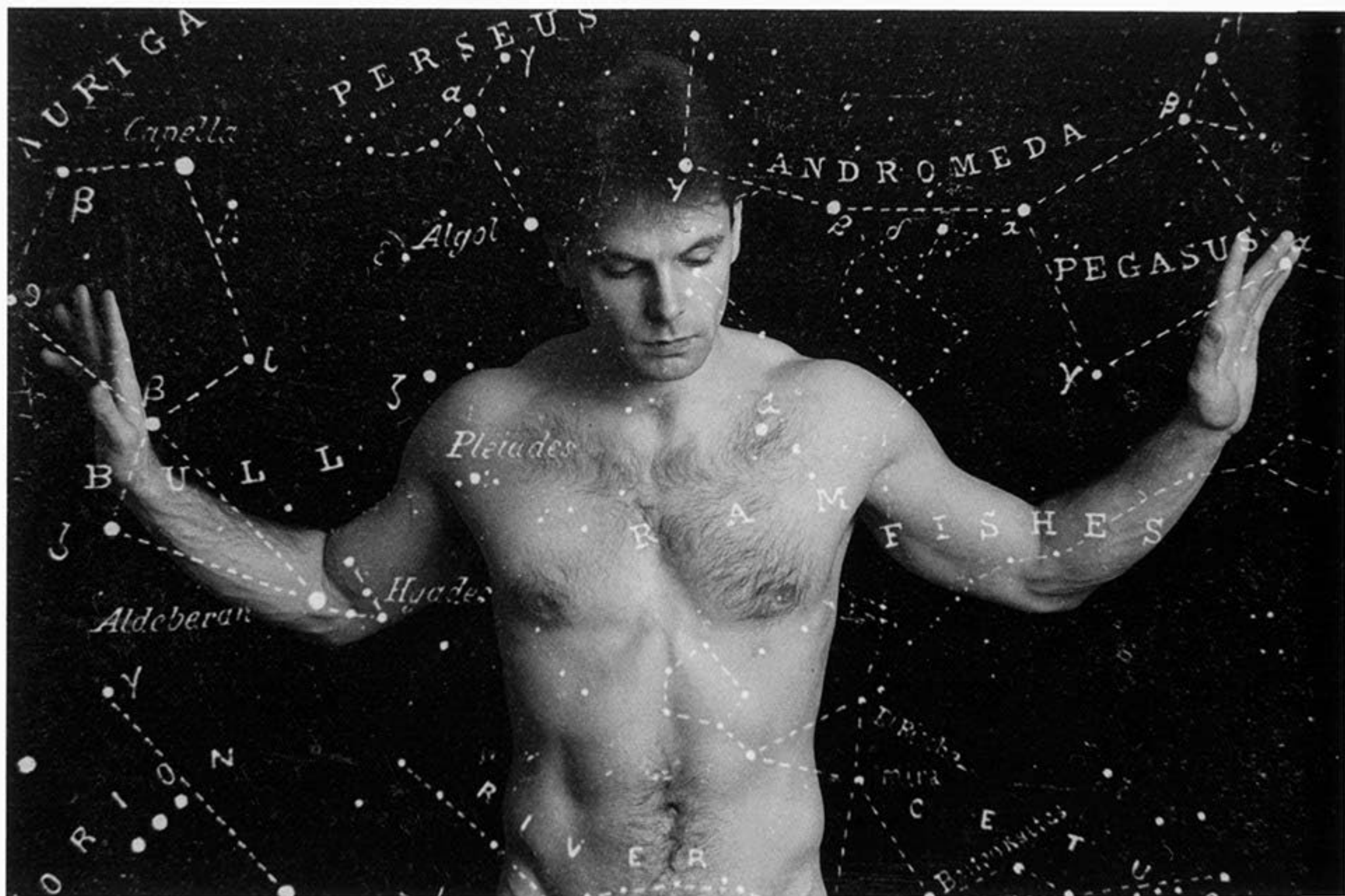
Once upon a time there was an upside down place, but the people

who lived there thought it was right side up, Everything came from nothing and all things were tall and small at the same time.







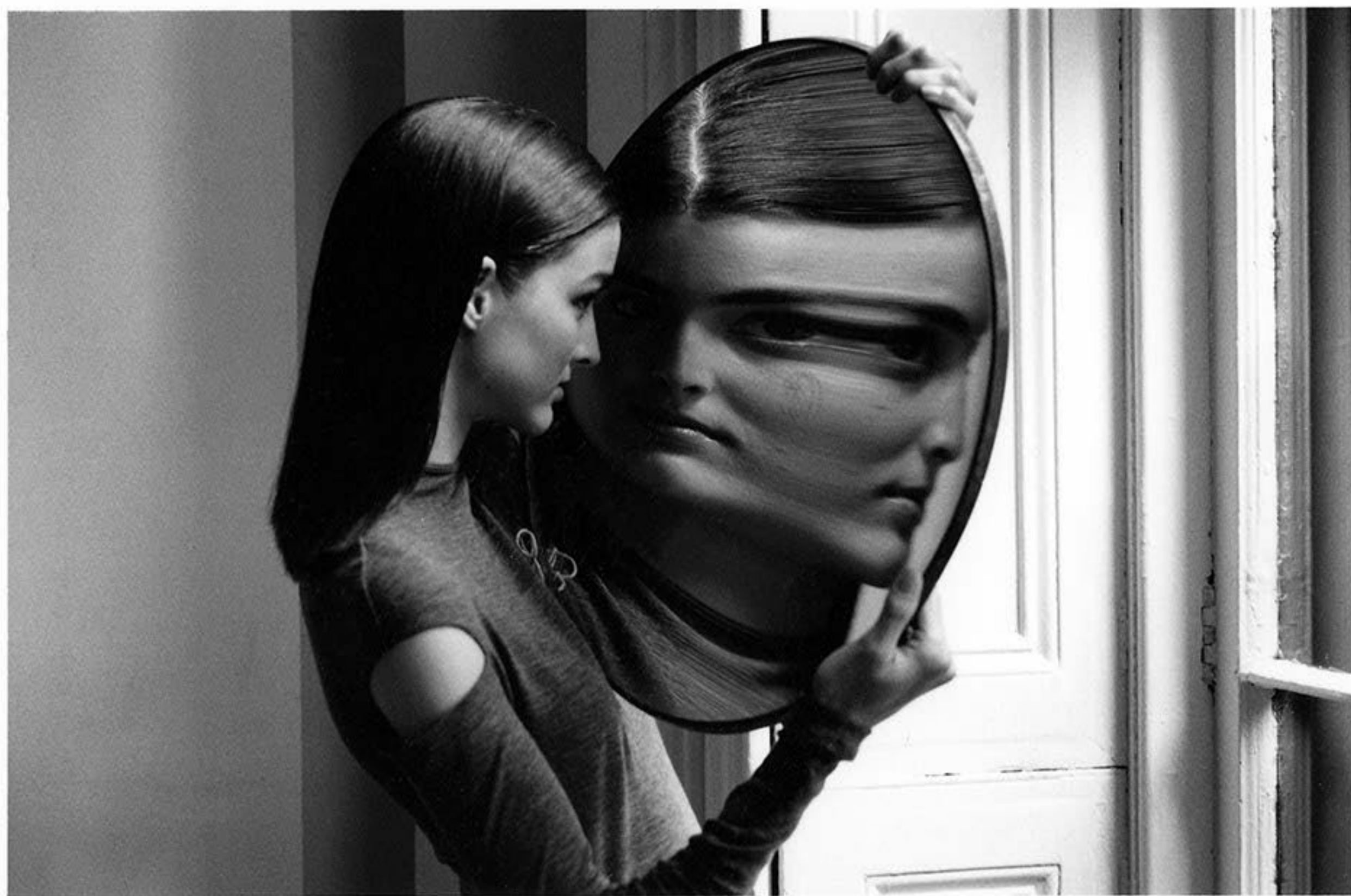
Everything seemed to stay, but in fact they went away. All about them looked the same and what they thought they became. *Where they came from* and where they would go was something they could never know.

invite confusion.

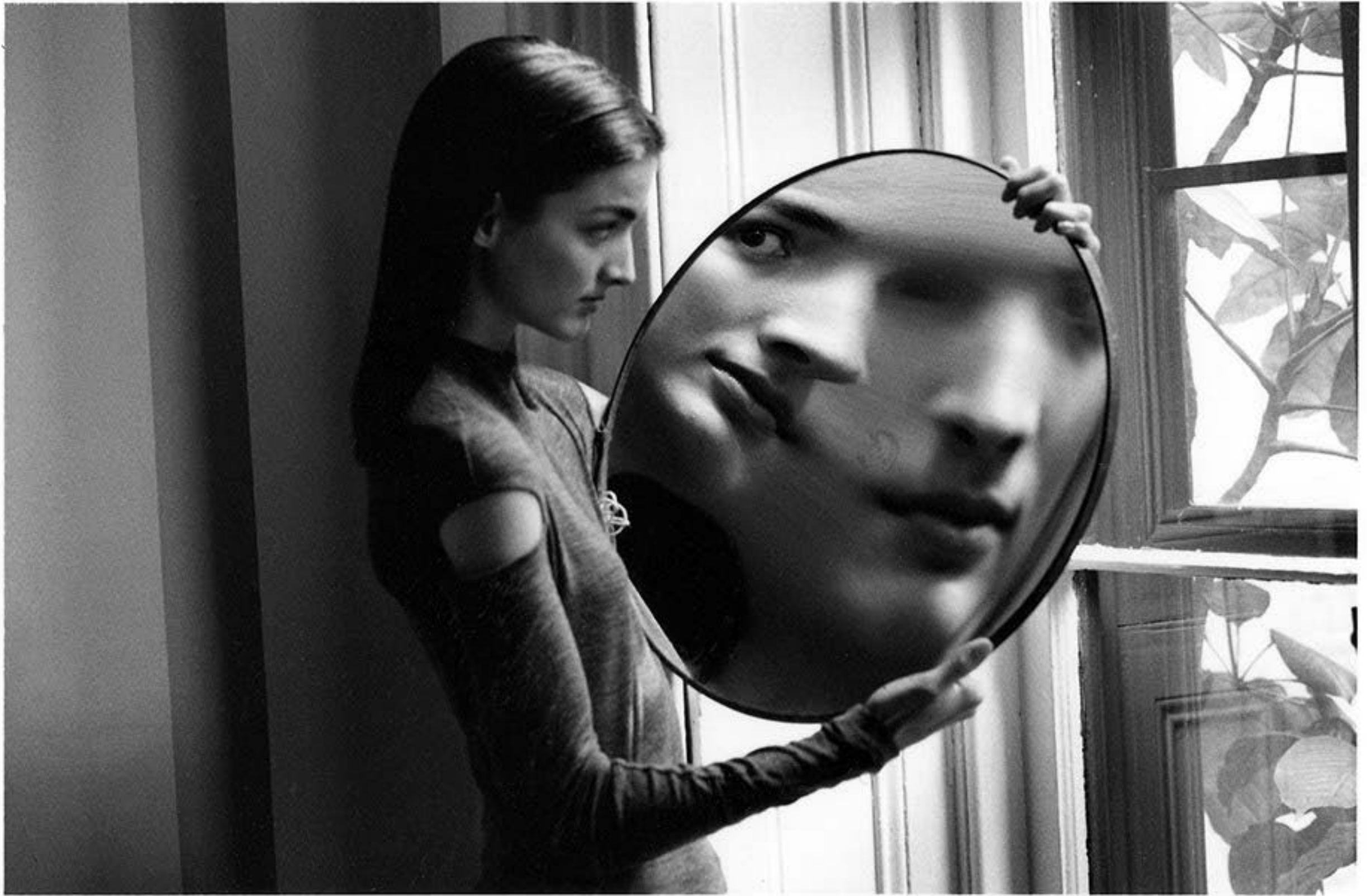

outside the box:

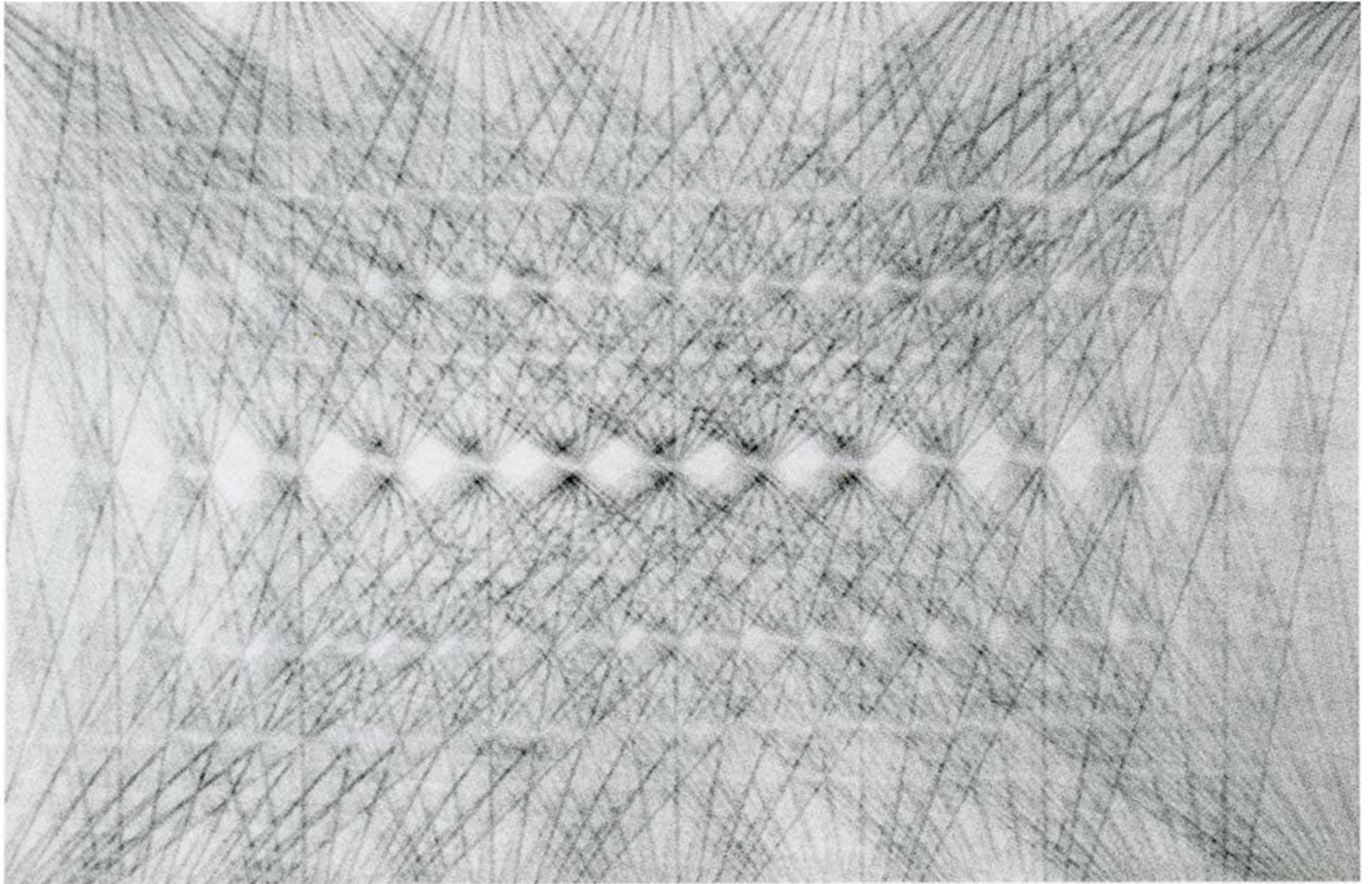


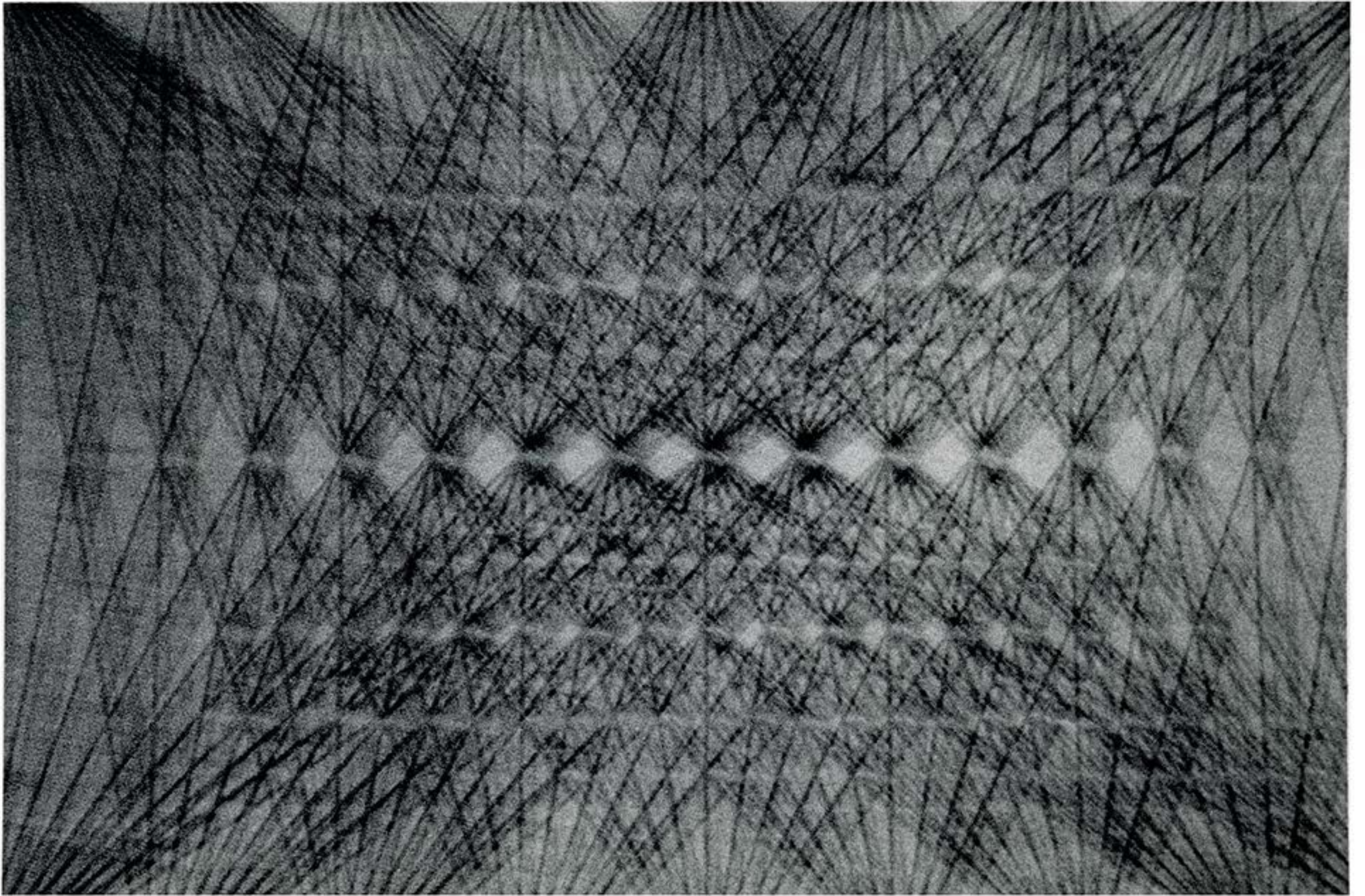
